

Communication & Language:

- * Listen to and follow instructions.
- * Distinguish between different sounds eg: instruments or environmental sounds.
- * Listen to stories with increasing attention.
- * Developing conversations.
- * Developing language during pretend play.

Maths:

- * Recite numbers in order.
- * Count using our fingers during number songs.
- * Count steps, claps, jumps etc.
- * Begin to recognise some numerals to 10.
- * Use language of more/less to describe quantities.
- * Compare objects by length/size.
- * Explore some common 2d shapes.

Personal, Social and Emotional:

- * Learn the classroom rules and expectations.
- * Play in a group, listening to the ideas of others.
- * Sharing and turn taking.
- * Demonstrating friendly behaviour towards others.
- * Follow toilet and washing hands routines independently.
- * Talk about healthy foods we like to eat.

Physical Development:

- * Developing fine motor control.
- * Strengthen hands by rolling, pinching, patting, squeezing using malleable materials.
- * Using climbing and balancing equipment.

Understanding the World:

- * Talk about differences/similarities between ourselves and others.
- * Talk about our families and home.
