

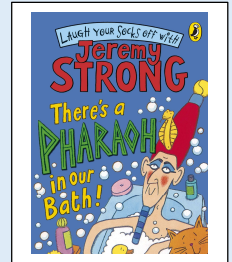
## 'Egyptology' Eagles - Year 3 Spring Term

### Key Areas of Learning



As **Historians** and **Geographers**, we will be learning about the great historical period of the Ancient Egyptians. From Gods and Goddesses, fantastic pharaohs, we will also navigate the power of the mighty Nile and begin to understand its effect on the land and the people. As **writers**, we will be studying the myths and legends of Egyptian times including the important characters of Isis, Osiris and Set. We will then use our knowledge to become Egyptian dramatists and scriptwriters. We will also be using, *The Scarab's Secret* to inspire our creative writing when focussing on describing a setting. We will also be enjoying the work of Author Jeremy Strong as we read the story 'There's a Pharaoh in our bath'.

As **Scientists**, we will be looking at *light, dark and shadows* (very important to the Ancient Egyptians)! We will even be taking this further afield and become *Shadowologists* in our art work (inspired by the Belgian artist, Vincent Bal). In the second half term we will focus on *roots and shoots* and the importance of how to grow healthy plants (and their requirements) much like the Ancient Egyptians.
