



Mandarins Year 2 Spring Term 2023 By The Sea



## Key Areas of Learning

In History children will develop their awareness of the past, using common words and phrases to describe the passing of time. They will learn about the life of Grace Darling and why she is remembered. They will use stories, pictures, and drama to help understand key events in her life.

In Geography, children will learn about the human and physical features of the coast and how these places differ from their immediate locality. They will name the continents and oceans of the world. They will consider ways in which we can look after the environment.

In English children will explore a range of picture books with a historical and geographical themes and use these to inspire writing. They will write a biography of Grace Darling. We will write poetry using a Michael Rosen poem and end the spring term with some story writing using the text Stardust by Jeanne Willis.

### **ENGLISH**

Children will continue to read and spell using the Rocket Phonics Next Steps programme. They will learn some spelling rules, e.g. adding er, est and ing to words, using the possessive apostrophe and contractions. In whole class reading sessions all children will practise their reading fluency and comprehension.

### **MATHS**

This term children will learn to use money to make amounts. They will begin to use groups and arrays as an introduction to multiplication and division. They learn to interpret and draw simple pictograms. They learn to recognise and describe 2D and 3D shape including symmetry. They begin to learn how to recognise and find a fraction of a shape and number.

# MUSIC

In music children will learn songs to sing and perform and develop their understanding of pitch and rhythm.

### SCIENCE

Children will learn about animals and their offspring including humans. They will learn about the importance of exercise, healthy minds, hygiene and food.

### ART

Children will develop painting and mixed media knowledge and skills. They will explore the work of Sonia Delaunay, Jasper Johns and Clarice Cliff.

Children will learn about Passover and why this important to the Jewish faith. They will learn The Easter Story and why the resurrection is important to Christians.
