Key Areas of Learning

As **Historians**, we will be learning about the coming of the Tudors and how they rose to power. We will be looking into the family tree of this famous family. As **Scientists**, our focus will be on physics this term, all around sound. How sound travels through vibrations, the ear as well as exploring pitch and volume. Culminating in planning, investigating, and evaluating our volume experiment.
